<u>Content</u>	

The Government launched in October 2010 a new strategy to combat ghettoization and the existence of parallel societies.

Among the 30 planned initiatives the strategy includes special restrictions for persons who apply for family reunification, while living in a ghetto (in Danish: udsatte områder).

Other planned initiatives include demolition of flats and obligatory child-care (obligatorisk dagtilbud) of 30 hours each week for children at the age of 3 which level of Danish language is deemed to be non-satisfactory compared to the age of the child.
